ELIGIBILITY:

The applicant must:

- Be an African-American female
- Be a graduating senior attending a Denver Metropolitan area high school
- Have a grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale (unweighted gpa).
- Have applied to an accredited technical school, certificate program, college or university.
- Not be a daughter of a Delta.

SELECTION:

This is a Needs Based Scholarship—Applications will be evaluated on the following criteria.

- **Financial Need:** Applicants must submit a valid, **signed** copy of their parents'/guardians' **IRS Form 1040 for the year 2017—(pp. 1 & 2 only) and W-2 or 1099 (whichever is applicable) must accompany the application.**
- **Scholastic Record:** An **Official Transcript** (from the school registrar—in a sealed envelope), or copy of the high school diploma/GED certificate. Transcripts should include GPA, class rank and a copy of ACT or SAT scores must accompany the application.
- **Personal Statement/Essay:** The typed essay of at least 250 words should address personal goals, academic achievements and why you believe this scholarship will have a positive impact on your educational and career goals.
- **Community Service Activities:** on a separate page.
- **Recommendations:** Two letters of recommendation must accompany this application—one from a teacher or educator (on school letterhead) and one other from a person familiar with the applicant's community service. The letters should address the personal characteristics and leadership skills/abilities of the applicant that will enable her to meet and exceed the demands of pursuing an education. **Both letters must be signed.**
- **Interview:** Applicants selected will be invited to interview with the scholarship committee.
- **Orientation/Reception:** Applicants selected to receive a scholarship **must** attend a Parent/Student Orientation and Awards Reception in May or the award will be forfeited.

THE APPLICATION DEADLINE— POSTMARKED BY March 1, 2019

It is the applicant's responsibility to submit a completed application and all supporting documents in one package and *postmarked by the deadline.* No consideration will be given to incomplete or late applications.
