Our programming provides educational opportunities and life skills to combat the stigma of academic failure and low self-esteem all the while providing mentoring and insight into new career avenues.

The Delta Academy is designed for:

- ◆ Young women ages 11 – 14.
- ◆ Young women who have potential but need guidance, support and skills to achieve success.
- ◆ Young women who are interested in cultivating service learning.
- ◆ Young women looking toward the future with career and collegiate aspirations.
- ◆ Young women who need encouragement and support in pursuit of higher learning.
- ◆ Young women who are interested in developing their leadership skills.
- ◆ Young women who are interested in community action and social change.
- ◆ Young women who have an interest in non-traditional careers including those in math, science, engineering and technology.

Our implementation of the program includes monthly meetings, workshops, service projects, social events, and cultural activities.



Delta G.E.M.S is a natural outgrowth and expansion of the highly successful “Dr. Betty Shabaaz Delta Academy” created to “catch the dreams” of at-risk, adolescent girls aged 14-18. Delta G.E.M.S. provides the framework to actualize those dreams through the performance of specific tasks that develop a “CAN DO” attitude.

Delta G.E.M.S. is geared toward inspiring and enriching young women. Delta G.E.M.S will participate in public service projects, college preparatory workshops, bonding activities, a college tour and social outings.

The goals of the Delta G.E.M.S Program are:

- ◆ To develop strong, confident and respectful young ladies and prepare them to take an active role in their success and society. To instill in girls the need to excel academically.
- ◆ To provide tools that will enable girls to sharpen and enhance their skills to achieve high levels of academic successes.
- ◆ To assist girls in proper goal setting and planning for their futures.
- ◆ To create compassionate, caring, and community minded young women by actively involving them in service learning and community service opportunities.
